RECOMMENDED ACTION

Acknowledge receipt of a presentation regarding the Public Infrastructure Plan (PIP) effort from the Truckee Meadows Regional Planning Agency (TMRPA).

BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION

The 2019 Truckee Meadows Regional Plan was adopted on October 10, 2019. As part of the update, TMRPA staff, together with staff from the jurisdiction and entities, sought to continue increasing our regional understanding of public infrastructure across jurisdictions and entities. This was encapsulated in Policy PF 3 – Creation of a Public Infrastructure Plan (PIP), which requires the creation of the identified plan. The PIP will assist TMRPA in more effectively carrying our statutory requirements regarding the connection between planning and public infrastructure.

The PIP effort officially kicked off in February, 2023, and is a component of the 2024 Regional Plan Update process. The goals for the effort:

Goal 1: Create a Public Infrastructure Plan Document that addresses the public facilities and services listed in RP policy PF 1 and as described in NRS 278.0274 subsections 4 and 5 through narrative chapters and references to existing plan documents.

Goal 2: Coalesce and combine available data on existing and planned infrastructure and service provision, both spatial and non-spatial data, to create a one-stop-shop for this information.

Goal 3: Design and implement policy improvements to the 2019 Regional Plan, based on narrative description and data compilation, in advance of the 2024 5-year Regional Plan update.

This presentation will provide members of the Citizens Multimodal Advisory Committee with an introduction to the effort, and an update about where we are at in the overall process.
