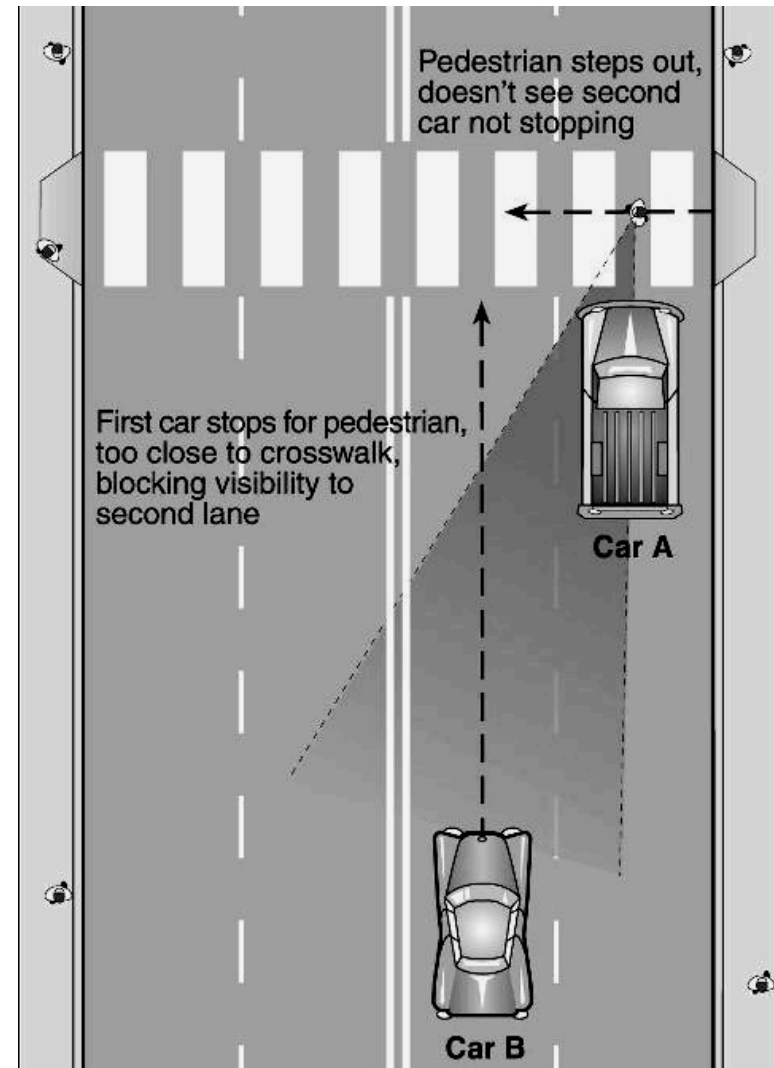


# Multiple Threat Crash

## Problem:

First car stops to let pedestrian cross;

First car masks second car, which doesn't stop, hits pedestrian at high speed.



# Multiple Threat Solution

**Drivers: Never pass a car that could be stopped for pedestrians. It's the law.**

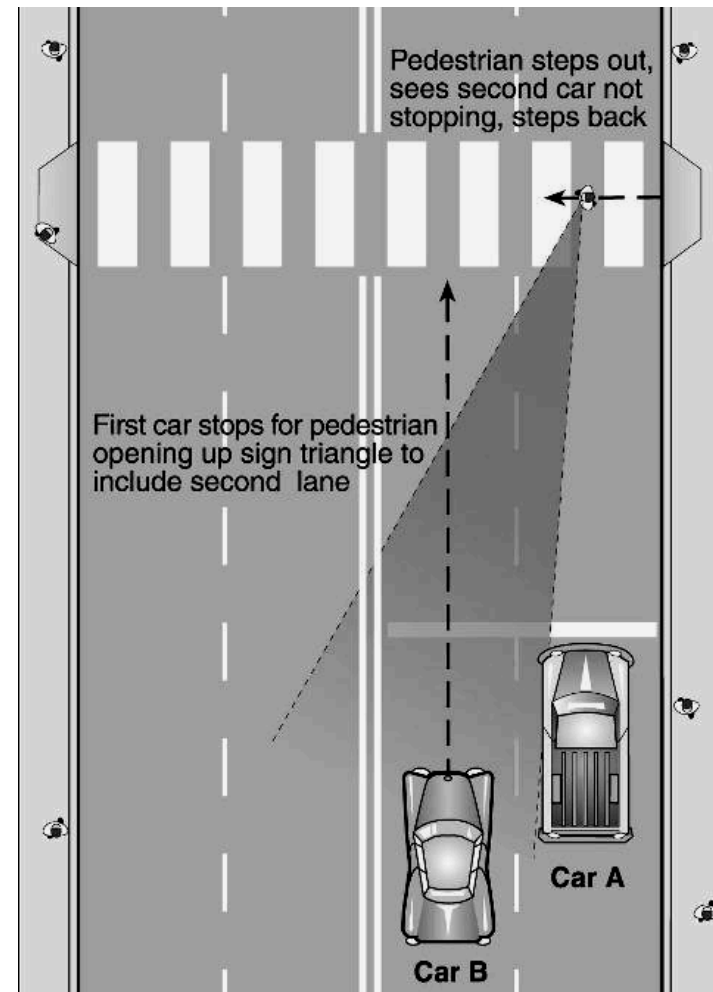


**Pedestrians: Keep watching for cars. Don't assume other cars will stop because one has.**

# Multiple Threat Prevention through Traffic Engineering

**Advance Stop Bars – can help  
prevent Multiple Threat crash**

**First car no longer masks  
second car, which can be  
seen by pedestrian.**
