<u>THE JOB:</u> Under general supervision, the **Engineer I** will manage technical (civil) engineering projects in design, construction & maintenance of transportation systems.

Under general supervision, the **Engineer II** will manage technical (civil) engineering projects in design, construction & maintenance of transportation systems and provide leadership in community outreach activities.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Engineer I: Bachelor's degree in engineering or a closely related field; AND two (2) years of experience in the design & construction of street & highway projects; OR any equivalent combination of education & experience that provides the required knowledge, skills & abilities. Requires a valid driver's license at time of hire.

Engineer II: Graduation from an accredited college or university with a bachelor's degree in civil engineering or a closely related field; AND three (3) years of professional civil engineering experience as a licensed engineer in construction, design or traffic engineering; OR an equivalent combination of education and experience that provides the required knowledge and skills. Current registration as a Professional Civil Engineer required with ability to obtain registration as a Professional Engineer in the State of Nevada within one year of hire. Requires valid driver's license at time of hire.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS: **Engineer I**: The ideal candidate will have knowledge and experience in design & project management activities related to the delivery of street and highway civil engineering projects using various funding sources including state and federal grant programs.

Engineer II: The ideal candidate will have knowledge and experience in design & project management activities related to the delivery of street & highway civil engineering and/or traffic engineering projects for state and local agencies using various funding sources including state and federal grant programs.
